The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is rebuilding M-14/I-96 between Sheldon Road and Newburgh Road in Plymouth Township and the city of Livonia in 2026. The project includes repairing 18 bridges, rebuilding project-area ramps, and upgrading drainage systems.

2026 Ramp Detours

Northbound I-275 to Westbound M-14

1. Continue north on I-275 to westbound I-96
2. Take southbound US-23 to reach westbound M-14

Southbound I-275 to Westbound M-14

1. Continue south on I-275 to westbound I-94
2. Take northbound US-23 to M-14

Westbound M-14 to Southbound I-275

1. Continue west on M-14/I-96 to southbound US-23
2. Take eastbound I-94 to reach southbound I-275

Westbound M-14 to Sheldon Road

1. Continue west on M-14/I-96 to northbound Beck Road
2. Take eastbound Five Mile Road to reach Sheldon Road

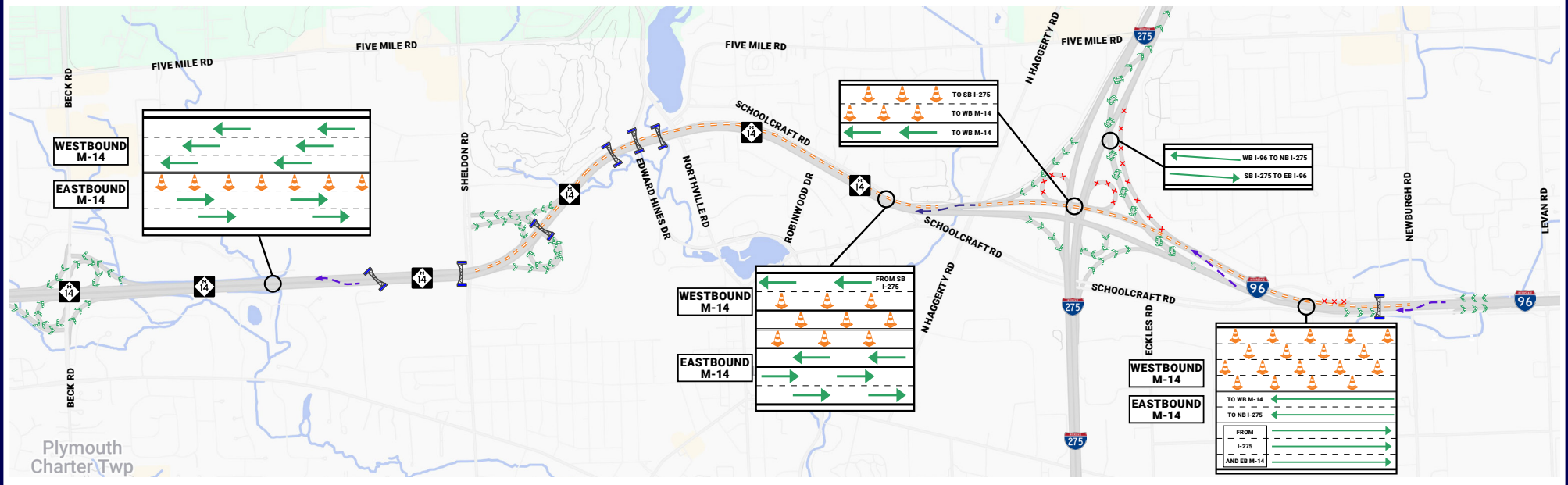
Newburgh Road to Westbound M-14

1. Continue south on Newburgh Road to westbound Ann Arbor Road
2. Take northbound Sheldon Road to westbound Five Mile Road
3. Take southbound Beck Road to reach westbound M-14
